Instead of remaining calm and quiet, our community needs to continue Cesar Chavez's legacy of struggle - we need to organize, defend our rights, and fight for what's best for our families and community.

We demand:

- No justice, no peace! Killer and abusive cops, off our streets!
- End the checkpoints and 30-day impounds!
- Documents and permanent residency rights for all: the right to work, higher education, drivers' licenses and public benefits.
- An immediate end to raids and deportations.

"A realistic analysis of who benefits from our oppression will clearly show that the head and heart of our movement must be the community and it is our present unorganized state which allows the migra, police, and politicians to bully us. History and experience have shown that unity and organization are capable of transforming a situation of passive acceptance into one where people are able to defend themselves from a position of strength and can take the initiative in the fight for a dignified future. An optimistic, assertive, and selfdetermined people are capable of overcoming the fear, hostility, and general corruption of those who take aim at us."
